- 1. From a point P outside line segment AB = 6 cm, construct a line PQ parallel to line segment AB.
- 2. Draw a line CD parallel to given line AB at a distance of 5.5 cm from it.
- 3. Draw a pair of parallel lines at a distance of 4.5 cm from each other.
- 4. Draw a line AB, take a point C outside it. Through C draw a line parallel to AB using ruler and compass only.
- 5. Draw a line PQ. Take a point C on it and draw perpendicular. Mark a point D on this perpendicular line at a distance of 4.5 cm from PQ. Through D draw a line parallel to PQ.
